FENG SHUI

For many people, Feng Shui is a contemporary trend in interior design – a way of decorating your home in a Chinese style. For others, it is an alternative form of medicine, a sort of religion or a paranormal phenomenon. For everyone, however, it is good business! Just look at the Feng Shui websites and you will find plenty of reading materials, courses, counselling and decorating services, all of them ready to ‘Feng Shui’ you at a price. But what is Feng Shui, really?

Feng Shui, which means ‘wind and water’, is a form of art and science believed to have started in China more than 6,000 years ago. It derives from the ‘I Ching’, the essence of traditional Chinese culture, to which only the imperial family and the nobility had access.

The first book about Feng Shui was written centuries ago and contained such obscure explanations that it was almost impossible to understand. Gradually, other books were written in a simpler, more accessible way, but even today only a Chinese or Taiwanese master of Feng Shui can accurately interpret their contents.

When the Communist regime took over in China, the practice of Feng Shui was prohibited, so the nobility and the rich upper classes escaped to Taiwan, taking all their ancient books and knowledge with them. The few masters who did stay behind died without leaving disciples or written records to continue their teachings. Fortunately, China is now a more open and flexible society and traditional Feng Shui is slowly returning to its birthplace.
